Dear Parents,

I want to start by thanking the majority of our families who have graciously adapted to and followed our revised arrival and dismissal procedures for this school year. Unfortunately, however, in these first few weeks, I have witnessed a number of individuals who have *continued to violate* the rules that have been established and shared. In the interest of the safety of our students, staff, families, and neighbors, it is vital that all parents abide by these **4 simple rules**:

**1. STUDENTS MAY NOT ARRIVE AT THE BUILDING PRIOR TO 8:15AM**

Please do not drop students off prior to then, as supervision is not provided.

**2. PLEASE FOLLOW THE APPROPRIATE ONE-WAY TRAFFIC PATTERN**

As shown on the previously shared map, vehicles should come down Terhune and turn left on Chestnut in front of the building. Vehicles should NOT approach the school on Chestnut from the other direction.

**3. STUDENTS MAY ONLY CROSS AT THE CROSSING GUARD / CROSSWALK**

Please do not walk your children across the street at any other location. You must park legally (not on a yellow curb or blocking any driveway) and walk them to the crosswalk.

**4. AT DISMISSAL, THERE IS TO BE NO PARKING OR STANDING OF ANY VEHICLES ON THE YELLOW CURB IN FRONT OF THE SCHOOL**

The front of the school is for *busses only* at dismissal. Parents must find legal street parking on a surrounding street and walk to pick up their child(ren) if they haven't granted permission for them to walk home or to their car.

The TCSCO has ordered traffic signs to help remind all of these procedures, for which we are very thankful. In addition, we will be working with the Teaneck Police Traffic Bureau to assist with monitoring the situation in the coming days and weeks. As a community, I am confident that we can all work together to ensure the safety of our students, staff, families, and neighbors by doing our part and abiding by these 4 simple arrival and dismissal rules. Your cooperation and assistance is truly appreciated!
