Qualifications for Summer Academic Intervention Teacher:

- Current NJ teacher certification valid for elementary and/or middle school instruction
- Experience teaching at-risk elementary aged and/or middle school students

Job Summary for Summer Academic Intervention Teacher: Summer Academic Intervention Teachers will provide specialized interventions/instruction to identified at-risk students who are exhibiting a significant achievement gap. Teachers will plan lessons and activities to address and monitor progress on academic skills. Teachers will report to the Director of Special Services and work collaboratively with parents, fellow teachers and other professionals as needed to ensure the needs of each student is being met.

Duties and Responsibilities for Summer Academic Intervention Teacher:

- * Provide instruction/intervention that is conducive to progressing within in academic deficit areas
- * Apply appropriate strategies to educate at-risk students, in compliance with State and Federal regulations.
- * Develop and nurture the emotional, cognitive and social abilities of the students.
- * Respond to student misbehavior appropriately and successfully.
- * Demonstrate clear and accurate oral and written communication.
- * Monitor student progress and complete an end of program progress reports.
- * Demonstrates regular and predictable attendance.
- * Work cooperatively with staff, students and parents.
